#### **BIMSTEC-India Marine Research Network (BIMReN)**

BIMReN, a joint initiative by the Ministry of External Affairs of India (MEA) and the Bay of Bengal Programme Inter-Governmental Organisation (BOBP-IGO), is a platform for facilitating collaboration among the researchers in the Bay of Bengal Region, for sustainable development of blue economy by networking the researchers in the BIMSTEC Member Countries.

The BIMReN has the following two components:

- 1. **BIMReN Split-site Fellowship** is for doctoral candidates from BIMSTEC countries to undertake part of their PhD research in Indian Universities and Research Institutions.
- 2. BIMReN Twinning Research Project Grant is a Small Grant Scheme that aims at facilitating collaborations between institutions and individuals with expertise in fisheries/marine/ocean sciences from BIMSTEC Member Countries, to implement research programs of regional interest. This component has an inherent provision for 12 person-months of faculty exchange, wherein four project partners shall undertake 3 months of research in the labs of their BIMSTEC counterparts.
